She insisted that all nurses and doctors wash their hands before treating patients.</li> <li>This helped to stop the spread of disease and saved many lives' Edith was a British nurse. At the start of World War 1 Edith Cavell cared for many wounded soldiers, including many German soldiers, at the Red Cross Hospital.
