If you have an appointment before the end of the school day you are welcome to take your child/ren home afterwards if you wish. Please ask a member of staff who will collect them from the classrooms for you.

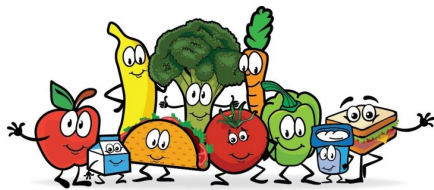


Healthy Packed Lunches
