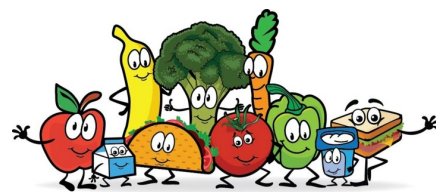
Healthy Packed Lunches
