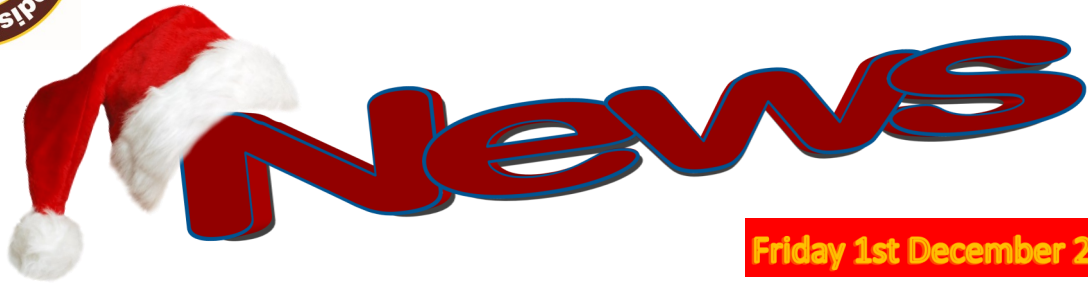

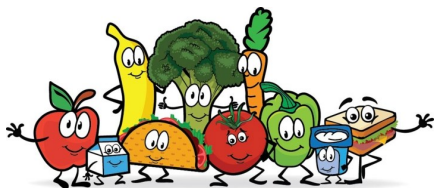
### Healthy Packed Lunches

Although the next few weeks are very exciting we would like to remind you how important full attendance in school is to your child/ren.

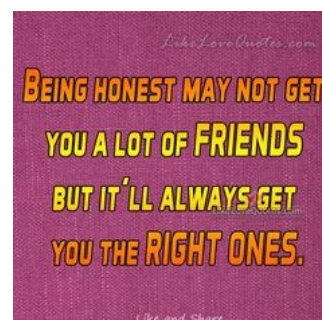
The children will still take part in lots of learning everyday and we want all of our children to take part in all the exciting plans we have arranged in school for them.
