Friday 1st March—British Values Day

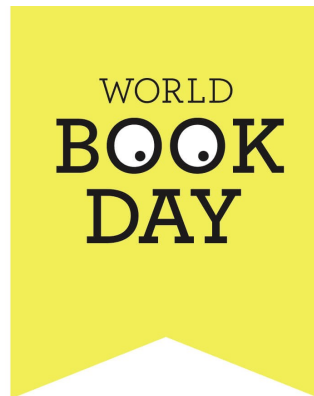
Come to school wearing red, white & blue for £1.50 donation (cash to the office please)

Here are some examples for some inspiration:

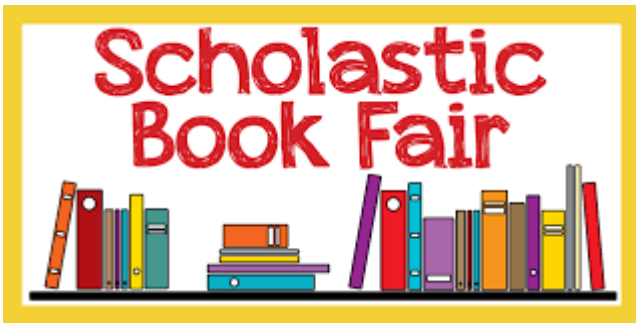

Wednesday 20th March we have some dental students from Uclan university visiting school and would like all our children who are 5 years old to take part in their research.

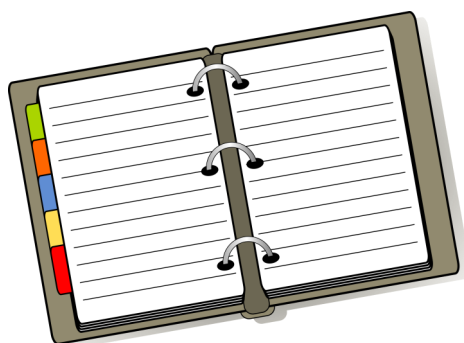
A letter will come home next week to gain your consent. The dental team will take a quick look at your child's teeth. No treatment will be provided and all clean materials will be used.
