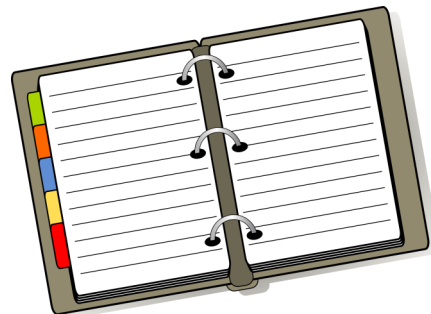

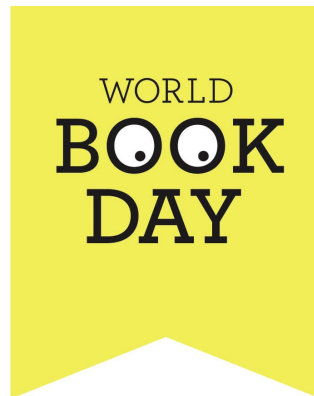

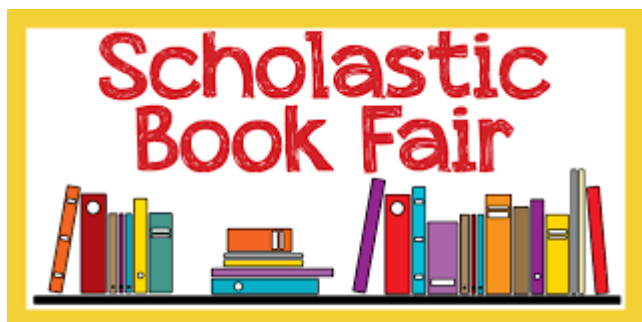

Apologies but this club can only be opened up to siblings who attend our school at the moment.

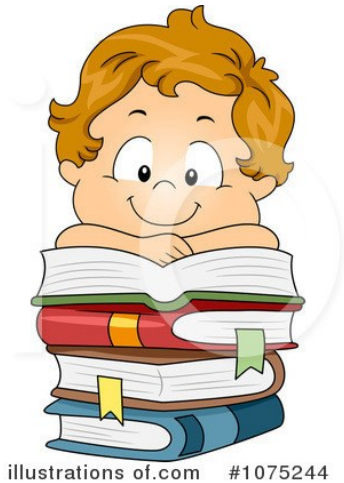
We will be taking part in our annual Bunny Hop to raise money for Pendleside Hospice and our school fund again on Thursday 25th April.
