We look forward to seeing you all next week.

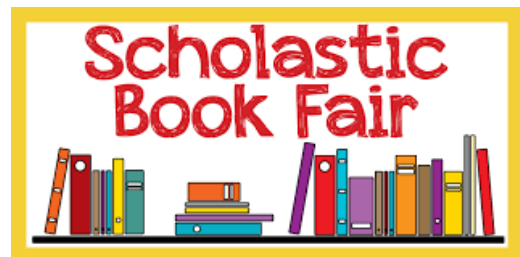
Our Book Fair is in school and available in the hall after school today, Monday and Tuesday at parents evening.

**Children who are aged 5 will take part in a dental survey next week. You should have received a consent form for this. If you haven't returned this yet, please could you return the form to the office by Monday**

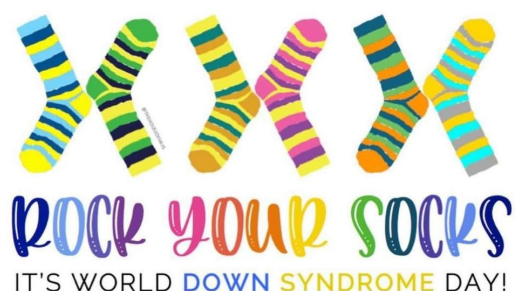

Please send your £1 coins in a named envelope

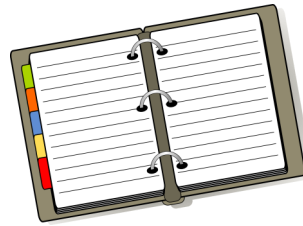

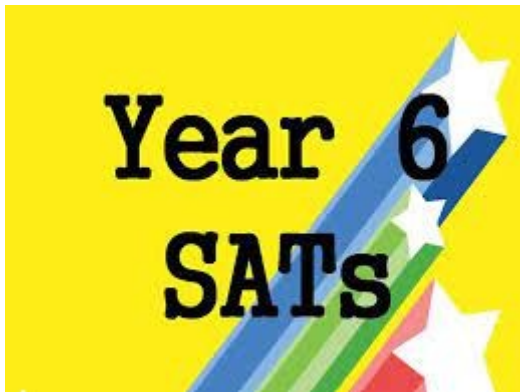
Our Christian value this half term is—**Love**
