Dear Parents, I would like to thank you for your amazing support during this unprecedented time. I know how hard it has been for everyone and I really do appreciate everything you have done in working with us, to help settle the children into school. We have had such a positive start to the year and we have had no tears...well we have had lots of tears but that was only from you the parents!

For all the parents with children new to Hapton this is our 'learning letter'. These will be sent out to you every half term. It is important that you read these letters as they will keep you informed about what is happening in Class One during each half term.

This first half term our focus is on settling the children into school life and supporting them to develop positive relationships with other children and adults in school. Our topic this half term is called 'Marvellous Me'.

In maths we will be assessing the children's mathematical knowledge and understanding in a fun and interactive way. We will also be learning about number, place value and shape.

Throughout the day the children will have 2 x20 minute fun and interactive phonic sessions. In Literacy/English we will be looking at 'traditional rhymes, labelling and instructions'.

Our PE day will be on a **Monday** starting from the 21st of September. The children are to come into school **in** their P.E kit. They can wear tracksuit bottoms/leggings, a hoodie/jumper and trainers. Children do not need to bring their uniform into school as they will stay in their PE kit all day.

The children will also carry out lots of learning in the outdoor area. Please can you make sure your child has a warm coat, a hat, gloves and a scarf during the winter months. If possible a pair of wellies to leave in school would also be helpful. Please label each item.

In Class 1 we also have Mrs Roberts, Mrs Brodie and Mr Fisher working with us, please say hello to them if you see them at the gate.

Thank you for signing up for the Dojo App (if you haven't done so already please do it ASAP). This will be a vital tool in keeping us connected throughout the year. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to ask.
